This Dunhuang cycling tour highlights the wonderful bicycle tour in the beautiful desert. Besides, top attractions such as the renowned Mogao Grottoes, Singing Sand Dunes, and ancient Great Wall of the Han Dynasty will not fail to impress you.

Date	Destinations	Attractions, Meals & Transport
1	Day 1 Dunhuang	 private airport/railway station transfer in Dunhuang  lunch  Crescent Moon Lake & Singing Sand Dunes The Crescent Moon Lake & Singing Sand Dunes are famous attractions in Dunhuang. From a distance make sure to listen carefully for the whistling tunes among the sand dunes. If you are feeling adventurous, take an optional camel ride (on your own expense).
2	Day 2 Dunhuang	 breakfast, lunch  In the morning, take a bicycle ride (about 25 km) to Mogao Grottoes (UNESCO), the world's most important site of ancient Buddhist Culture. The treasure house contains hundreds of sandstone caves holding more than 2,000 statues and 45,000 brilliantly bright paintings of Buddha and Chinese mythological figures. Later, return to downtown by bike and back to your hotel.
3	Day 3 Dunhuang	 breakfast, lunch  In the morning, take a car ride (about 80 km) west across the desert to Yumen Pass , which was the west terminal of the Great Wall built in Han Dynasty 2,100 years ago. Then, ride a bicycle to Yangguan Pass and Yangguan Pass Museum (about 50 km) . Yangguan is the key pass along the southern part of the Silk Road as well as the door for the communication between western countries and China.
4	Day 4 Dunhuang	 private airport or railway station transfer in Dunhuang  breakfast  Service ends.
