240-Hour Visa-Free Transit in China

China is implementing a 10-day (240 hours) visa-free transit policy. The transit program allows visitors who have existing flight bookings from China to a third country (region) to snag a visa on arrival at a Chinese airport (port) and stay for 10 days before departure. Hong Kong, Macao and Taiwan all count as third destinations.

Passport holders of 54 countries, including the United States and the United Kingdom, can enter visa-free through any of the 60 open airports (ports) in 24 provincial regions, covering popular tourist cities like Beijing, Shanghai, Xi'an, Chengdu and Guangzhou.

Meanwhile, citizens from 38 countries can enter China visa-free for up to 30 days.

1	Day 1 Qingdao	airport-hotel transfer in Qingdao
2	Day 2 Qingdao	After breakfast, take a full day excursion in Qingdao City. At first visit Small Qingdao Islet, a tiny and fancy islet lies 720 meters off the shore. The islet is dotted with numerous beautiful corridors, sculptures, waterside pavilions, and gazebos surrounded by various kinds of flowers and pines. Afterwards, stroll through the Zhan Bridge, which was originally built in 1891 as a naval pier. Zhan Bridge can be regarded as a construction as old as Qingdao City. Then visit Tsingtao Beer Museum, China's first and the oldest beer factory. In this classic European style architecture, you could know about beer production techniques and machinery, as well as the long and rich history of Tsingtao beer. Then head to Badaguan (Eight Great Passes), which is made up of eight streets named after the eight great military forts of ancient China. Located along these famed streets are a number of houses and villas dated back to Qingdao's Germanconcession era from 1897 to 1914.

3	Day 3 Qingdao - Qufu (by bullet train)	Temple of Confucian, Kong Family's Mansion, Cemetery of Confucius The Temple of Confucian is built on the site of Confucius' former residence, and is recognized as the first Temple of Confucius in the history. It has a wide influence on the oriental architectures. The Kong Family's Mansion was used to be the residence of Confucius and his families. The Mansion boasts luxury furnishings, exquisite decorations, and precious cultural relics. The Cemetery of Confucius is the largest family cemetery with the longest history in the world. There rested Confucius and his descendents.

4	Day 4 Qufu - Tai'an (by automobile)	breakfast, lunch Dai Temple, Mount Tai Visit the Dai Temple - the largest and most completed ancient building complex of Mount Tai. Take a visit to the Mount Tai (UNESCO). You'll take a cable car to go up the mountain. It is reputed as the top one of the 'Five Sacred Mountains in China'. In the history, many poets and literary scholars also visited Mount Tai to gain inspiration and you could find many cultural relics and stylish stone tablets left by them.
5	Day 5 Tai'an	railway station transfer in Tai'an breakfast Service ends.
6	Getting there & away:	There are several bullet trains leaving from Beijing or Shanghai each day, so you could easily choose any train that fits your travel schedule. To make your trip convenient we also provide train or flight ticket booking service. Beijing – Qingdao: 1.5 hours by air, 4.5 - 5.5 hours by bullet train Tai'an – Beijing: about 2 hours by bullet train Shanghai – Qingdao: 1.5 hours by air, 6.5 hours by bullet train Tai'an - Shanghai: 3.5 hours by bullet train
