

# Fujian Tulou & Wuyi Mountain Discovery Tour - 6 Days

In this 6-day tour of World Heritage Sites, you will marvel at the Tulou clusters in Nanjing and Yongding, and explore the astonishing Wuyi Mountains, one of the most famous Danxia Landforms in China.

#### 240-Hour Visa-Free Transit in China

China is implementing a 10-day (240 hours) visa-free transit policy. The transit program allows visitors who have existing flight bookings from China to a third country (region) to snag a visa on arrival at a Chinese airport (port) and stay for 10 days before departure. Hong Kong, Macao and Taiwan all count as third destinations.

Passport holders of 54 countries, including the United States and the United Kingdom, can enter visa-free through any of the 60 open airports (ports) in 24 provincial regions, covering popular tourist cities like Beijing, Shanghai, Xi'an, Chengdu and Guangzhou.

Meanwhile, citizens from 38 countries can enter China visa-free for up to 30 days.

1	Day 1 Xiamen	airport transfer in Xiamen
2	Day 2 Xiamen - Nanjing - Yongding (by automobile)	private transfer of Xiamen/Nanjing/Yongding  breakfast, lunch  Today, take a 3-hour car ride to Nanjing to visit the World Cultural Heritage Site - Tianluokeng Tulou Cluster. Seen from the hill above, you'll find the architectural miracle looks like a table of Chinese dishes, nicknamed 'four dishes with a soup'. Afterwards, stroll around the Yuchang Mansion and the Taxia Village. Later, drive to Yongding.
3	Day 3 Yongding - Xiamen (by automobile)	private transfer from Yongding to Xiamen  breakfast, lunch  In the morning, explore the Yongding Tulou Culture  Village, one of the best-known groups of Fujian Tulou. Among those Tulou clusters, you'll find the 'Prince of Earthen Buildings' the Zhencheng Mansion, 'Mini' ones like Rusheng Mansion, 'Palace-like' Quiju Mansion, and other Tulous in all forms and shapes as well.  Afterwards, take a car ride back to Xiamen.

4	Day 4 Xiamen – Wuyishan (by bullet train)	train station transfer in Xiamen, train station – hotel transfer in Wuyishan  breakfast, lunch  Today, take a short ferry ride to the <b>Gulangyu Island</b> . Gulangyu boasts plenty of colonial villas, seaside gardens, and meandering alleys. It is also famous for hosting China's only piano museum, giving it the nickname of "Piano Island" or "The Island of Music".  Later, transfer to the train station and take a bullet train to Wuyishan city.
5	Day 5 Wuyishan	breakfast, lunch  Enjoy a full-day excursion to the <b>Wuyi Mountain</b> . Located in northwest Fujian Province, the Wuyi Mountain is known as the "most wonderful mountain in southeast China", and was listed as World Cultural and Natural Heritage in 1999. It is one of the most famous Danxia Landforms in China. You will visit the Cloud Cave, Jiesun Peak, Tea Cave, and take a bamboo raft along the Nine-bend Stream.
6	Day 6 Wuyishan	train station transfer in Wuyishan  breakfast, lunch  Today, continue to explore the Wuyi Mountains Scenic Area. Take a visit to the Harmonious Temple, Water Curtain Cave, and Eagle Mouth Rock. Then, learn about the history of the oolong tea at the Dahongpao Oolong Tea Plantation, the best Oolong tea plantation in the world. Later, transfer to the train station or airport in Wuyishan city. Service ends.
