1	Day 1 Shanghai - Suzhou (by Bullet Train)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• train station transfer in Shanghai, train station-hotel transfer in Suzhou</li><li>• lunch</li><li>• <i>Lingering Garden, The Surging Wave Pavilion, Grand Canal, Optional night tour in the Master of Nets Garden</i> The Lingering Garden is known as one of the "Four Famous Classic Gardens" in China, and was listed as the World Cultural Heritage by UNESCO in 1997. The garden was built in the year of 1593. As a classic example of the refined art of gardening in ancient China, it highlights the delicate courtyard, magnificent halls, the green mountain, clear water and luxuriant trees.</li></ul> <p>The Surging Wave Pavilion was built in 1045 AD. Being the oldest extant garden in Suzhou, it has retained its original feature of "luxuriant plants, tall mountain, and expansive waters". Its natural scenery and simple design have earned the fame of "a mountain forest in urban surroundings".</p> <p>Take a small boat trip along the Grand Canal and get close to the world's oldest and longest canal.</p> <p>Optional night tour in the Master of Nets Garden: The Master of Nets Garden (built in 1174 A.D.) provides an atmosphere of peace and calm in the evening. Inside the small and exquisite garden, the yellowish lights and red lanterns outline the pavilions and chambers built by water, displaying the nobleness and elegance of the Chinese garden. Besides, visitors can enjoy performances such as Kunqu Opera and Suzhou Pingtan in the garden. The night garden tour is available during mid-March to mid-November.</p>
2	Day 2 Suzhou - Hangzhou (by Bullet Train)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• train station transfer in Suzhou, train station transfer in Hangzhou</li><li>• breakfast, lunch</li><li>• <i>West Lake, Six Harmonies Pagoda, Qinghefang Historical Street</i> The West Lake (UNESCO) is famous for its natural beauty and historic relics and it has influenced numerous painters, poets, and garden designers throughout Chinese history. You will take a short cruise on the picturesque West Lake.</li></ul> <p>The Six Harmonies Pagoda is a masterpiece of ancient Chinese architecture. You can get a panoramic view of the Qiantang River on the very top.</p> <p>The Qinghefang Historical Street has been the most flourished street in the city since the ancient time. Hangzhou's century-old shops are all located in this area.</p>
3	Day 3 Hangzhou - Wuzhen (by automobile)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• private transfer from Hangzhou to Wuzhen</li><li>• breakfast, lunch</li><li>• <i>Lingyin Temple, Wuzhen Water Town</i> The Lingyin Temple is the biggest Buddhist Temple in southern China, which also features a large number of grottos and rock carvings.</li></ul> <p>The Wuzhen Water Town is a peaceful riverside town with tranquil pathways, ancient stone bridges, and delicate wood carvings. It will impress you with the picturesque scenery and its original lifestyle.</p> <p>Accommodation at Tong An Hotel or Wuzhen Guest House in Wuzhen Xizha Scenic Zone.</p>
4	Day 4 Wuzhen - Shanghai (by automobile)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• private transfer from Wuzhen to Shanghai</li><li>• breakfast, lunch</li><li>• Today, continue to explore Wuzhen by visiting Yichang Foundry Workshop, Water Market, Live Water Garden, Silk Workshop, etc.</li></ul> <p>In the afternoon, take a car ride to Shanghai and transfer to your hotel.</p> <p>Service ends</p>
