1	Day 1 Xining	 airport-hotel transfer in Xining
2	Day 2 Xining	 breakfast, lunch  <b>Sun and Moon Mountain, Qinghai Lake</b> Take a 2-hour car ride to the Sun and Moon Mountain. From the top of the mountain you could enjoy a splendid panorama of prairie and farmland. Located 3200 meters above sea level, the Qinghai Lake is the largest inland and salt water lake in China. The lake has different scenery in four seasons and has become a popular destination for biking and bird watching.
3	Day 3 Xining	 airport transfer in Xining  breakfast  <b>Dongguan Mosque, Ta'er Monastery</b> With a history of over 600 years, the Dongguan Mosque is the largest one in Qinghai Province and numerous of Muslims gather for daily prayer and Islamic festivals. Built in 1377 to commemorate Tsong Khapa (the founder of the Yellow Hat Sect), the Ta'er Monastery attracts tens of thousands of pilgrim every year. Service ends.
