240-Hour Visa-Free Transit in China







China is implementing a 10-day (240 hours) visa-free transit policy. The transit program allows visitors who have existing flight bookings from China to a third country (region) to snag a visa on arrival at a Chinese airport (port) and stay for 10 days before departure. Hong Kong, Macao and Taiwan all count as third destinations.

Passport holders of 54 countries, including the United States and the United Kingdom, can enter visa-free through any of the 60 open airports (ports) in 24 provincial regions, covering popular tourist cities like Beijing, Shanghai, Xi'an, Chengdu and Guangzhou.

2	Day 2 Xi'an	 breakfast, lunch, special dinner  Museum of Terracotta Warriors and Horses, Big Wild Goose Pagoda, a ceramic & pottery workshop en route, Dumpling Banquet & Tang Dynasty Show The Museum of Terracotta Warriors and Horses (UNESCO) is one of the greatest archaeological discoveries in the world. More than 6000 life-sized terra cotta warriors, archers, infantrymen, horses, and bronze chariots have silently guarded the tomb of China's First Emperor for over 2,200 years. The Big Wild Goose Pagoda, a Tang Dynasty landmark, is a seven-story pagoda initially constructed in 652 AD. One of the pagoda's many functions is to hold sutras and figurines of the Buddha that were brought to China from India by the Buddhist translator and traveler - Xuanzang. Enjoy a tasteful Dumpling Banquet followed by an exquisite traditional Tang Dynasty Show.

3	Day3 Xi'an - Mount Hua - Xi'an (by automobile)	 private transfer of Xi'an/Mt. Hua/Xi'an  breakfast, lunch  Mount Hua In the morning, take a car ride to Mount Hua (about 120km). As one of China's Five Sacred Mountains, Mount Hua is famous for its steep peaks, characteristic rocks, cloud seas and waterfalls. With the changeable climate on the mountain, you will enjoy spectacular scenes in different seasons. Besides the stunning natural view, Mount Hua is also home to several important Taoist temples, and it is also known as a centre for the practice of traditional martial arts. In the later afternoon, drive back to Xi'an and transfer to your hotel.
4	Day 4 Xi'an	 airport transfer in Xi'an  breakfast, lunch  Ancient City Wall , Great Mosque The Ancient City Wall is one of the oldest city walls in China and still encompasses the center of Xi'an today. The Great Mosque, which blends Islamic mosque styles and traditional Chinese architectural elements, acts as one of the oldest and best-preserved Islamic mosques in China Service ends.
