1	Day 1 Hong Kong	<p> Li Yuen Street East & West: Dive into these narrow "lanes of Central" to find a bustling open-air market famous for bargain fashion, accessories, and traditional Chinese garments.</p> <p>Stanley Street: Stroll through this lively thoroughfare known for its historic open-air food stalls (dai pai dong) and its significant role in the city's early revolutionary history.</p> <p>Pottinger Street (Stone Slabs Street): Climb the iconic granite steps of one of Hong Kong's oldest streets, a popular filming location lined with stalls selling festive costumes and handicrafts.</p> <p>Hollywood Road: Explore the world's "second coolest street," where antique shops and contemporary art galleries meet vibrant murals and colonial heritage.</p> <p>Man Mo Temple: Step into this atmospheric 19th-century temple dedicated to the gods of Literature and War, famous for its giant hanging incense coils.</p> <p>Lan Kwai Fong: Pass through the city's most famous nightlife district, a compact maze of streets packed with over 90 restaurants and bars.</p> <p>Central-Mid-Levels Escalator: Ride the world's longest outdoor covered escalator system to enjoy a unique perspective of the city's tiered urban landscape.</p> <p>Tai Kwun: Visit this meticulously restored colonial-era police station and prison complex, now a premier hub for heritage and contemporary art.</p> <p>PMQ: Conclude your tour at this former police married quarters, now a creative landmark housing local design studios, workshops, and chic boutiques.</p>
