


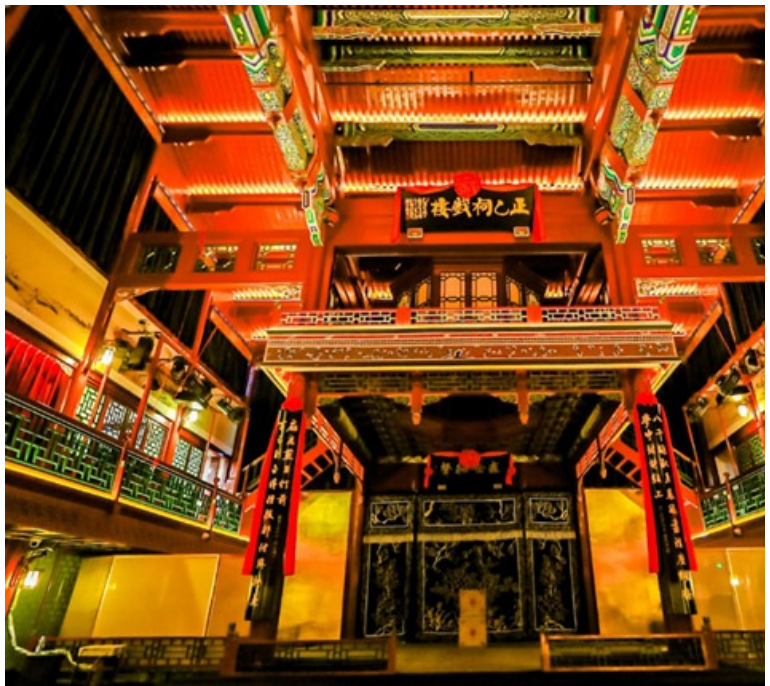


Ancient Chinese Opera Culture and Costume Play Tour - 1 Day
