2	Day 2 Beijing	 breakfast, lunch  Tian'anmen Square, Forbidden City , Temple of Heaven (UNESCO) Stand in the heart of modern China at the world's largest public square, a site of profound historical significance and grand architectural scale. Walk into or drive through (sedan/minivan) Tian'anmen Square to marvel at its iconic surroundings, including the Monument to the People's Heroes and the Great Hall of the People. Step into the majestic imperial palace where 24 emperors of the Ming and Qing Dynasties ruled for five centuries. Explore the ceremonial courtyards and the exquisite private quarters of the royal family. Note: Closed on Mondays. In case of closure or ticket unavailability, the itinerary adjusts to Jingshan Park for a premier panoramic view overlooking the entire Forbidden City. Discover the Temple of Heaven, a timeless masterpiece of traditional Chinese imperial architecture. For centuries, ancient emperors held grand solemn rituals here to worship heaven and pray for favorable weather and abundant harvests. Admire its exquisite layout, profound cultural connotations and classic imperial architectural charm that embody ancient Chinese cosmology and ritual traditions Dinner Suggestions: Iconic Peking Duck Indulge in a signature feast at a renowned, time-honored restaurant. Savor the legendary roast duck, celebrated for its signature crispy skin, tender meat, and the subtle aroma of fruit-wood roasting.

3	Day 3 Beijing	breakfast, lunch The Summer Palace (UNESCO), Hutong Tour, Lama Temple Wander through the world's largest and best-preserved imperial garden. Originally designed as a royal summer retreat, it features an exquisite collection of classical pavilions and bridges centered around the tranquil Kunming Lake. The Hutongs are the historic arteries of Beijing, a network of narrow alleys that have defined the city's soul since the Yuan Dynasty (1271 AD). More than just passages, they represent the pinnacle of China's traditional neighborhood life and vernacular architectural art. From a bird's-eye view, the seamless integration of these winding lanes and classic Siheyuan (courtyards) resembles an intricate, orderly chessboard, hiding a world of delicate gardens, scholarly rockeries, and ancient relics that whisper stories of a bygone era. The Lama Temple has a reputation of the largest and best-preserved Tibetan Buddhist Lamasery in Beijing. The building and artwork of the lama Temple is a combination of Han and Tibetan styles.
		private transfer from Beijing downtown to Mutianyu breakfast, lunch Wangfujing Street Wangfujing Street is a pedestrianized shopping street. It is home to upscale shopping malls, souvenir shops and street foods. You may find lots of dining options and shops for all kinds of budgets here. Following your leisure time and shopping at Wangfujing, take a comfortable private transfer heading north straight to the scenic foothills of the Mutianyu Great Wall. Step out of the vehicle and refresh your senses in the crisp mountain air. Before ascending the wall, take time to unwind and browse the vibrant Mutianyu Cultural & Creative Stores at the service plaza, or step into the high-tech XR Experience Hall to witness the virtual changing seasons of the ramparts and interact with digital ancient warriors. Lunch at Yisonglou Nestled at the foot of the Mutianyu Great Wall, Yisonglou Restaurant has been a culinary landmark since 1987. Spanning three floors with a scenic observation deck, the restaurant offers more than just a meal—it provides a front-row seat to the majesty of the rolling mountains. During your visit, savor the authentic tastes of Huairou with a curated selection of signature local delicacies: Steamed Rainbow Trout: Sourced from the cold, clear running waters of Huairou, this local specialty is celebrated for its incredibly tender, delicate flesh. Expertly steamed to preserve its nutritional integrity, every bite showcases the freshness of the mountains. Braised Pork with Chestnuts: A Huairou classic, this dish is a perfect marriage of succulent, slow-cooked pork and the region's legendary sweet chestnuts. It is a nourishing, "melt-in-your-mouth" experience where the richness of the meat meets the natural sweetness of the nut.

Braised Pig Face: A celebrated local delicacy, this rustic and savory dish is renowned for its rich texture and depth of flavor—offering a bold, authentic taste of traditional Northern Chinese mountain cuisine.



As the fierce midday heat fades, ascend the mountain during the mid-afternoon "Golden Hour," when the softening sunlight bathes the ancient ramparts in a warm, amber glow—perfect for capturing dramatic, crowd-free photography as the architectural lines become stunningly three-dimensional.



Overnight at the **Mutianyu Great Wall Hotel**, a tranquil sanctuary cradled by the ancient Ming Dynasty ramparts, where uniquely styled courtyard rooms offer a peaceful mountain retreat far removed from the urban bustle.



Afterward, enjoy a relaxing midday interlude to browse the vibrant **Mutianyu Cultural & Creative Stores** at the service plaza, or step into the high-tech **XR Experience Hall** to witness the virtual changing seasons of the wall and interact with ancient warriors.

5	Day 5 Beijing	 airport/train station transfer in Beijing  breakfast  Hongluo Temple Known as the cradle of Northern Chinese Buddhism, Hongluo Temple is a serene, thousand-year-old imperial sanctuary nestled against the lush, pine-covered foothills of Hongluo Mountain. Far removed from the urban rush, this sacred complex invites travelers to wander through ancient, mist-shrouded temple halls and pristine botanical wonders, including a vast, emerald sea of bamboo that has flourished for centuries and a pair of legendary, intertwined Ginkgo trees that bathe the courtyards in brilliant gold each autumn. Walking along the peaceful stone pathways, listening to the gentle echo of prayer bells, and breathing in the crisp mountain air, you will discover the perfect harmony of profound Zen spirituality and majestic natural ecology that once captivated China's emperors.
