

## Exploring Three Parallel Rivers - Songtsam Yunnan Circuit - 9 Days

This trip is for adventurous travelers looking for an experience that offers physical and cultural activities, wildlife discovery, and untouched off the beaten path regional exploration. From the stunning views of the highest snow peak in Yunnan to the lush and floral Mekong valley, this trip takes you through the heart of the Three Parallel Rivers area and reveals its living heritage.

### Meals

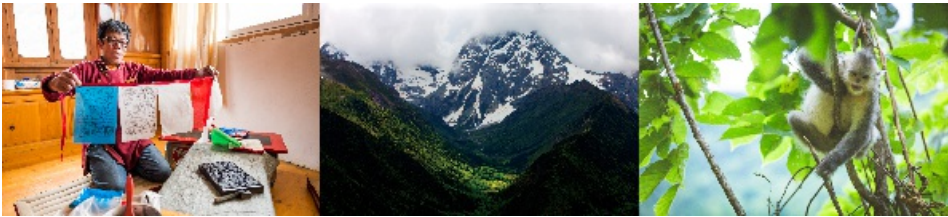

1	Day 1 Lijiang	<p> dinner</p> <p> -Pick up from Lijiang Sanyi International Airport.</p> <p>-Take part in a Dongba calligraphy class to learn about the Naxi hieroglyphic language and ancient Naxi culture if able to arrive early.</p> <p>-Welcome dinner at the hotel.</p> <p>Overnight at Songtsam Linka Lijiang (Altitude: 2,400m)</p>

Day2 Lijiang - Tacheng (by automobile)



breakfast, lunch, dinner



-After breakfast, depart for Tacheng.  
-Pass the First Bend of the Yangtze River and visit Shi Gu Village on the way.  
-Stop off for lunch at a local restaurant or lunch box  
-Continue onto Tacheng along the valley of Yangtze River and arrive in the afternoon. Once checked in, relax and take in sights of the beautiful rice and flower fields and the surrounding ancient village.  
-Dinner at the lodge.  
Overnight at Songtsam Tacheng Lodge (Altitude: 2,020m)

Day3 Tacheng



breakfast, lunch, dinner



-After breakfast, visit the Dharma Cave and take a walk along the road of pilgrimage (30 mins drive).  
-Return to the lodge for lunch.  
-Visit Hada Village in the afternoon to learn how to make soy milk and tofu with a local family in their courtyard.  
-Dinner at the lodge.  
Overnight at Songtsam Tacheng Lodge (Altitude: 2,020m)

Day 4 Tacheng - Cizhong (by automobile)



breakfast, lunch, dinner



- After breakfast, visit the Yunnan Golden Monkey National Park and hike for 1-2 hours into the nature reserve.
- Drive to Cizhong along the scenic upper Mekong River (4 hours drive).
- Have lunch at local restaurant or lunch box.
- Arrive at Cizhong in the afternoon and explore the nearby Catholic Church (option to join the mass after dinner – available on Mondays, Wednesdays, and Friday evenings).
- Dinner at the lodge.

Day 5 Cizhong - Meili (by automobile)



breakfast, lunch, dinner



- After breakfast, drive to Meili, stop at Qudengge, where local People get the “key” to worship Mt. Kawagebo
- Drive to Meili and have lunch at the lodge.
- In the afternoon explore the surrounding village and visit a local family to learn how to print prayer flags
- Return to the lodge for dinner.

Overnight at Songtsam Meili Lodge (Altitude: 3,600m)

Day 6 Meili



breakfast, lunch, dinner



-Experience the golden sunrise over Mt. Kawagebo.  
-After breakfast, take part in a small ceremony paying homage to Mt. Kawagebo with the prayer flags you printed yesterday.

Daily activity plan - choose one of the following:

\*Plan A: (only valid from May to Oct)

Follow in the footsteps of plant hunters to the alpine pasture and discover the local way of life.

\*Plan B:

Day hike into Baima Snow Mountain area for 4-6 hours with a picnic lunch.

\*Plan C:

Ride a bicycle or take a leisurely walk along the road around the Feilaisi viewing platform, which faces Meili Snow Mountain.

-Free leisurely time in the afternoon to relax.

-Dinner at the lodge.

Day 7 Meili - Shangri-La (by automobile)



breakfast, lunch, dinner



-Experience the golden sunrise over Mt. Kawagebo.

-After breakfast depart for Shangri-La, visiting Dongzhulin Monastery and the Moon Bay of the Jinsha River on the way.






-Stop off at Songtsam Lodge Benzilan for lunch.

-Continue onto Shangri-La and stop off at Napa Lake.

-Arrive in the late afternoon and have dinner at hotel.

Overnight at Songtsam Linka Shangri-La (Altitude: 3,300m)

### Hotels and lodges

#### Songtsam Linka Lijiang

Our retreat is located at a nearby small Naxi-ethnic village named Ciman, where the traditional way of living still thrives. Surrounded by pinewoods and a pear garden, Songtsam Linka Lijiang offers spectacular views of the old town, Jade Dragon Snow Mountain, and Lashi Lake. The hotel's design is grand in appearance and has an interior layout in the style of a Naxi courtyard that is decorated with exquisite Hui-style stone sculptures.



### Songtsam Lodge Tacheng

Part of a mixed Tibetan/Lisu farming community, Songtsam Tacheng enjoys a comfortable climate and boasts the region's most fertile land. The spacious and cozy rooms in the main building face beautiful terraced rice fields and mountains in the distance. The lodge is elegantly designed to showcase fine Chinese art and style; big windows and balconies enable guests to take in the stunning rural scenery.



### Songtsam Lodge Cizhong

A hundred years ago, French missionaries ventured into landlocked valleys of Yunnan province to share their religion. A century later, the churches that remain in these regions continue to thrive. Cizhong Catholic Church, where service in Tibetan is still held every Sunday, is the most beautiful of these churches, even after many years of disrepair. The Songtsam Cizhong lodge sits in this lovely Tibetan village, surrounded by the grapevine-covered slopes of local vineyards.



### Songtsam Lodge Meili

Built in an unspoilt village away from any tourists and overlooking the majestic Meili mountain range. Rooms are furnished with large comfortable beds, sofas, and timber flooring, providing a warm atmosphere that combines rustic charm with modern comforts. Most of the rooms come with a cosy fireplace and a stunning view of Meili Snow Mountain.



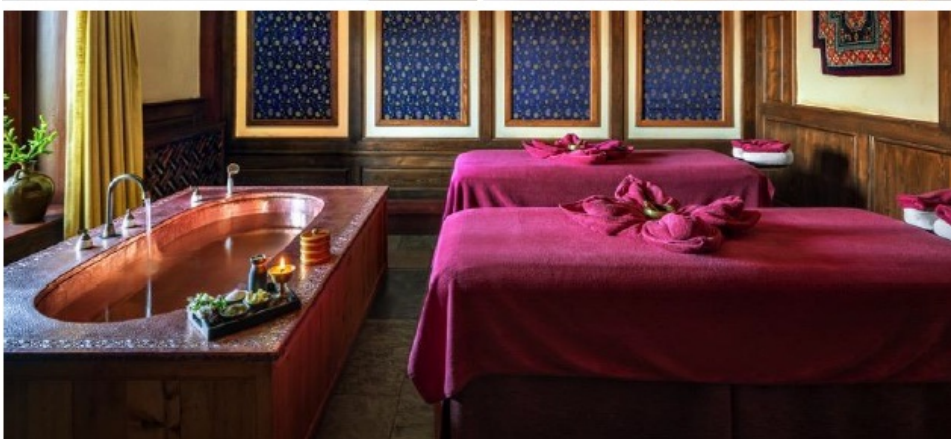
### Songtsam Lodge Benzilan

Nestled in an intimate green valley by the Yangtze River, Songtsam Benzilan features spacious guest rooms, all decorated in a modern Sino-Tibetan style. The lodge is surrounded by authentic white-walled Tibetan homes and has views of a small prayer house that rests atop a hill. From the lodge, it is an easy walk to the nearby hills and traditional Tibetan villages, where temples are decorated with beautiful murals.



### Songtsam Linka Shangri-La

Hidden in the city's peaceful and green valleys between Tibetan villages and Himalayan barley fields, our hotel is located a short distance away from the Songzanlin Monastery. Tibetan-style rooms, dining facilities, spa, and other modern amenities are housed in lovingly hand-built stone structures spread over 21 acres of hillside surrounded by snow-capped mountains.
