1	Day 1: Arrival in Beijing	 airport - hotel transfer
2	Day 2: Beijing	 breakfast, lunch  a pearl workshop en route, Mutianyu Great Wall, The Summer Palace (UNESCO) Visit China’s most famous monument and one of the best-preserved sections of the Great Wall. Known for its stunning watchtowers and beautiful forest scenery, your visit includes a round-way cable car ride for a comfortable and scenic trip up and down. Wander through the world’s largest and best-preserved imperial garden. Originally designed as a royal summer retreat, it features an exquisite collection of classical pavilions and bridges centered around the tranquil Kunming Lake.
3	Day 3: Beijing	 breakfast, lunch  Tian’anmen Square, Forbidden City , Temple of Heaven (UNESCO), a tea house en route Stand in the heart of modern China at the world’s largest public square, a site of profound historical significance and grand architectural scale. Walk into or drive through (sedan/minivan) Tian'anmen Square to marvel at its iconic surroundings, including the Monument to the People's Heroes and the Great Hall of the People. Step into the majestic imperial palace where 24 emperors of the Ming and Qing Dynasties ruled for five centuries. Explore the ceremonial courtyards and the exquisite private quarters of the royal family. Note: Closed on Mondays. In case of closure or ticket unavailability, the itinerary adjusts to Jingshan Park for a premier panoramic view overlooking the entire Forbidden City. Discover the Temple of Heaven, a timeless masterpiece of traditional Chinese imperial architecture. For centuries, ancient emperors held grand solemn rituals here to worship heaven and pray for favorable weather and abundant harvests. Admire its exquisite layout, profound cultural connotations and classic imperial architectural charm that embody ancient Chinese cosmology and ritual traditions
4	Day 4: Beijing - Xi'an (by bullet train)	 train station transfer in Beijing, train station - hotel transfer in Xi'an  breakfast, lunch  Lama Temple The Lama Temple has a reputation of the largest and best-preserved Tibetan Buddhist Lamasery in Beijing. The building and artwork of the lama Temple is a combination of Han and Tibetan styles.

5	Day 5: Xi'an	 breakfast, lunch  Museum of Terracotta Warriors and Horses (UNESCO), Big Wild Goose Pagoda, Terracotta Warriors and Horses Replica Factory The Museum of Terracotta Warriors and Horses (UNESCO) is one of the greatest archaeological discoveries in the world. More than 6000 life-sized terra cotta warriors, archers, infantrymen, horses, and bronze chariots have silently guarded the tomb of China's First Emperor for over 2,200 years. The Big Wild Goose Pagoda, a Tang Dynasty landmark, is a seven-story pagoda initially constructed in 652 AD. One of the pagoda's many functions is to hold sutras and figurines of the Buddha that were brought to China from India by the Buddhist translator and traveler - Xuanzang.
6	Day 6: Xi'an - Chengdu (by bullet train)	 train station transfer in Xi'an, train station - hotel transfer in Chengdu  breakfast, lunch  Ancient City Wall The Ancient City Wall is one of the oldest city walls in China and still encompasses the center of Xi'an today.
7	Day 7: Chengdu - Leshan - Chengdu (by automobile)	 private transfer in Chengdu & Leshan  breakfast, lunch  Leshan Giant Buddha The Leshan Giant Buddha is an enormous 230-foot Buddha, which is the largest stone-carved Buddha in the world. You will board a boat and head out into the Mingjiang River to get an overall view of the statue from afar.
8	Day 8: Chengdu - Guilin (by air/bullet train)	 airport/train station transfer in Chengdu, airport/train station - hotel transfer in Guilin  breakfast, lunch  Giant Panda Breeding Research Center The Giant Panda Breeding Research Center is a massive ecological and zoological park offers a wonderful chance to get face-to-face with China's national treasure. There is also a panda museum that has detailed exhibitions on panda evolution, habits, habitats and conservation efforts.
9	Day 9: Guilin	 breakfast, lunch  Li River Cruise, West Street In the morning, meet your guide at the hotel and transfer to embark on a memorable Li River Cruise. Through this 3-hour journey of China's best known natural scenery, you can appreciate unique karst landscapes as well as verdant hills and lovely waters. Then, arrive at Yangshuo at about 13:00 and enjoy the rest of the day at leisure. West Street is the oldest street in Yangshuo, which started to develop 1,400 years ago. The street is called the biggest 'foreign language center' in China as it fused western and eastern culture. More than 100,000 foreigners come here each year. You can explore the uniqueness of the street by having a stroll.

<p>10</p>	<p>Day 10: Guilin - Shanghai (by air)</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none">  airport transfer in Guilin, airport - hotel transfer in Shanghai  breakfast, lunch  Dragon's Backbone Rice Terraces, Zhuang Ethnic Village Today, take a 3-hour car ride to Longsheng. Longsheng is well known for its spectacular Dragon's Backbone Rice Terraces. It is a beautiful place where the Zhuang and Yao ethnic people have lived for over the centuries. In the spring, when the terraces are full of water, they resemble irregular silver ladders; and in autumn, when the rice ripens, the mountains turn into golden waves. Located within the stunning Longji (Dragon's Backbone) Rice Terraces, this traditional village offers a wonderful look into the culture of the local Zhuang people. You can admire their unique wooden stilt houses (Diaojiailou), see their traditional clothing, and experience a peaceful way of life surrounded by beautiful mountain landscapes.
<p>11</p>	<p>Day 11: Shanghai</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none">  breakfast, lunch  Yu Garden, Bund, Jade Buddha Temple, Nanjing Road, Shanghai Old Town Owing to its ingenious design in Ming and Qing dynasties, the Yu Garden becomes a real museum of Chinese ancient architecture. The Bund, featured outstanding European colonial architectures, is full of new skyscrapers and historical buildings in the center of Shanghai. The Jade Buddha Temple is famous for its two precious jade Buddha statues brought from Burma, which are not only rare cultural relics but also exquisite artworks. The Nanjing Road, a must-see metropolitan destination attracting thousands of fashion-seeking shoppers from all over the world, is a top prosperous center of Shanghai. Step back in time and experience the historical heart of the city at Shanghai Old Town, where classic Jiangnan-style architecture and bustling street markets offer a fascinating contrast to the city's futuristic skyscrapers. Anchored by the 16th-century Yu Garden and the lively bazaar surrounding the City God Temple, this vibrant district allows you to wander through labyrinthine alleys lined with traditional gray-brick buildings, cross the iconic Nine-Turn Bridge, and sample world-famous local delicacies like Xiaolongbao (soup dumplings) at historic eateries.
<p>12</p>	<p>Day 12: Shanghai</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none">  breakfast, lunch  Zhujiajiao Ancient Town, Zhang Yuan & Fengshengli With a history of more than 1700 years, the Zhujiajiao Ancient Town features lovely rivers, stone bridges, and historical buildings on the riverbank. A premier cultural and lifestyle landmark in Shanghai that seamlessly blends history with modern trends. Zhang Yuan is the city's largest and best-preserved Shikumen (stone-gate) architectural complex, recently restored into a high-end luxury and fashion district. Right next door, Fengshengli complements the historic charm with a vibrant, modern dining and lifestyle block filled with trendy cafes, popular restaurants, and lively bars. Together, they offer the perfect taste of Shanghai's unique heritage and contemporary urban energy.
